29/5/99 Pete and Steve M in Molino climbing the piton wall in the big chamber above the slither up. Pete's fall of 6ft is stopped by Steve's rope before it develops into an injury.

30/5/99 Pete Andy Juan Julie Kenny Arthur back to area above Los Hoyos in Cubija (see 7/4/99) ~~Juan descended~~ Inspected dig 1399 where Pete had removed a lot more rubble. Draughting in has dried out the mud a treat.

Juan + Pete descended 1401 11m to floor then slope down to above 13m total depth. No draught. Chokes. ~~Flow~~ Parallel drop meets main shaft at base. About 4m  $\phi$  at base.

Inspected 1402 where, ~~the~~ past the small entrance, the drop enlarges but then pinches in about 4m down. Not descended.

Into 1404 at base of steep shakedown. By leaning out over the top of the 4m drop, the shaft was seen to choke all the way round at the base.

New 1405 shaft on top left edge of depression (looking into valley) 10m shaft explored. 2m  $\phi$  choked.

8/6/99  
1406 Small cave entrance to N of track has a rift behind a boulder in floor on R where stones seem to drop into somewhere bigger. <sup>5m below</sup> A 5 minute dig will enable a look.

3/5/99 Penny & Iren walking up from Mosligo and backward & forward along cliff lines on NE side of Cubija. Above Portón (76) is small cave 1407. Sm. long with small second entrance.

Walked to nose of El Naso, just to look over to La Secada and then walked back at highest cliff line. Came across open holes just at end of cliff on 'plateau'. Must be known? Check on map.

Last 10 minutes of walk back in on hailstone shower.
