23/7/06 Penny + Ivan: Mission to relocate Cueva Seta.

Obvious cold depression to right of old track to the west of
barn at the start of the Mushroom Field.

Needs digging out but should be possible — can see down
a few metres — but nothing drops down the 9m pitch.

Seta-site 93 @ 30T 4798123 045287,

Then found the jungle towards Porabado rather problematic,
Eventually got up to the track to Superfostabio and back.

24/7/06 Cueva del Maro - Carm Haskell + Pete Smith

- Mission to survey passage beyond old end.

We reached the old end without incidents, and
after a little breaking off calcite we got through
the first set of squeezes. Then one member of the team
got stuck between a stalactite and the floor and had to
be dragged out by the feet by the other member, who
promptly decided enough was enough. The first member
broke off the stal and continued alone but even so
failed to reach the limit of earlier exploration. A halt
was made where the passage turns to the right with

more cobbles on the floor. It then gets smaller with water -

a good excuse to turn back.
(about 50m from 1st squeezes)

- Result: failed to survey passage
- Conclusion: smaller, fitter, harder cavers required

A site 2485 30T 0449393 4800226

Cold hole. Rubbish bags and leaves. Small slope down onto boulders. Dried up trough and tiny rising in depression above. Small, boulders to u-bend, too small. Draught from holes in floor.

B site 2486 30T 0449345 4800222

3x2m shaft top in trees about 6m deep with a slope of dead things that needs 6 months or so to decay away.

C2 site 2487 30T 0449365 4800255

The entrance is at the base of a 5m high limestone scar in a wooded depression. Squeeze down over large block to roomy 'chamber'. Excavated slope to higher level and a boulder choke with the draught coming up from below.

Site 2488 30T 0449360 4800255 Surveyed.


5m to the west of site 2477 is a draughting low bedding that enlarges after 5m with another rising crawl to a small boulder choke. To the right ...

D site 2489 30T 0449382 4800258

Depression with many trees and a cold draught. Spiral down through blocks to chamber with inlet passage and outlet passage with draught. Narrow rift seems to close in but could be pushed.

E site 2490 30T 0449458 4800263

Cold draught comes up from between rocks at base of smaller depression.


28/7/06 Tabbans 2, 3 & 4. Ali + Steve

(2491) Tabbans 2 - entrance opened up, dug down in a narrow rift in base of widening out. Good draught from too narrow slot at top.

(2492) Abandoned & capped with rocks.

Tabbans 3 - open entrance found about 10m to right of T2. Entrance opened up. Block removed, but large flake prevents progress - will need demolition. Can see ~5m in at least, descending at about 40° .

Tabbans 4 - draught noticed in grass in gallery about 4m below T2. Opened up to reveal small opening with good draught coming from rift - approx $\frac{1}{2}$ m high 10cm wide. Abandoned & capped.







30/7/06 Explorations in Downstream Riano

Footleg & Caroline.

Went to investigate inlet a short distance downstream of entrance series, which trends northwards towards El Torno.

This inlet was surveyed in 1991 but not written up in logbook and never drawn up on survey. We took a pointout of the survey centreline down to sketch the detail on. Found that the pitch in the entrance series is easily free climbed via a traverse over the drop. Quick progress downstream from main stream junction down easily climbable cascades to 4m vertical drop. Water sinks down slot just before lip. We took a rope to descend this drop, but discovered an easy traverse over top into phreatic passage beyond. Another passage turns right off this passage, leading to an easy climb down into the streamway of the inlet we had come to investigate. From where we arrived in the inlet a low airspace crawl leads downstream, but is bypassed by a short muddy moonmilk crawl into the chamber containing the pool below the 4m drop in the main stream. This makes a quick bypass to the 4m pitch.

We then headed upstream in the inlet, sketching as we went. Much of this passage is crabwalking in tall rifts. At the end some crawling in bedding planes leads past some stals to a sump. Just before the stals a draughting hole was seen at floor level on the right (looking upstream). This hole is too tight but a climb up over the stal gives access to about 4m of passage to a draughting area. We climbed this to near the top, but it pinches to about 20cm with what looks like a wider phreatic passage above. Possibly worth capping into?

Heading back out we climbed up a ~~small inlet stream~~ calcite flow to investigate a small flow of water. The water came out of a small hole but a separate phreatic passage led off at roof level. This had signs of previous travel

and ended where it got too low. We continued downstream in the roof of the main inlet passage and found another phreatic side passage that had no signs of previous exploration. Followed this for ~ 80m to a junction. Left was choked after a short distance. Right led to an aven after about 10 m. The aven is ~ 10 m high with passage going off at the top but we could not climb it due to the loose nature of the walls about 5m up. It could probably be bolted up. We just could not traverse into it from the passage because of the ledges of loose pebbles near the ceiling.

We continued back in the inlet passage at roof level for some way but found no more side passages before the traversing became too difficult. Climbed back down to the stream level and headed out.

July 29
Sat. July 28th - not sure of date but definitely Saturday
Patrick + Carmen visit Tonto chamber to check out accuracy of survey of Rampant Rabbit.

Two leads out of chamber = lowest point, easily digable cobble crawl with weak draft. Farthest NW point is strong draught exiting chamber over too low crawl on mud - would need ~~2-3~~ days effort probably to clear to furthest visible point (6m or so). Next to this on L. is "tube tube" - best left alone....

Climb up giant sloping slab enters a crawl over a pool and a short pass. to a chamber. L. inlet is horrible rift later connected to canyon below "Wingles junction." R. inlet is 3m climb, short canyon to chamber & climb up mud to pop out into a very large NW-SE trending rift. NW & ("downstream") leads to boulder falls. The ~~one~~ apparent main way on ~~one~~ is W. & but is boulder choked - small crawl at floor ^{level} is too tight.

Obvious ancient stream flow into choke at this point. Above climb up at end of big rift gains a ~~small~~ large chamber with boulders. Phreatic pass. leads off R. but gets too small after ~30m.

Writing as of August 2nd - we know of no further leads in this area apart from end of grab described on next page

1/8/06 Torno. Pete B, Ali N, Andy J, Patrick W, Carmen M.

Into Torno Chamber where Pete took photos. Patrick showed Andy where he & Carmen had climbed out of chamber on Saturday, also looked at dig sites at bottom end of chamber. Returned to others. When photoing was finished we split into two groups. Patrick & Carmen returned to the big passage they had climbed up into from Torno chamber. No way or was found at the water end of this. (shallow) Pete, Ali & Andy went to end of Rampant Rabbit, to look at any inlets or the return. Pete agreed that end choke is loose & not nice. First point of interest on way back was Stat chamber - on RHS on Ester survey. They had to short passage in the roof with pretties. The passage crossed the main drag in otherwise on LHS. By 60 line we got to next inlet. (on RHS) Patrick & Carmen were in it. So ~~we~~ we went on to the next inlet. (also on RHS) Pete entered this to find a maze. He soon had vocal contact with Patrick & Carmen. They agreed to continue survey. Patrick says: Inlet goes to a choke but climbs of 3m & 4m enter a phreatic tube maze above Rampant Rabbit, with a loop back. At one point at highest point have broken into a chamber in next bed of limestone up - many fine shaws.

Whilst this was going on Pete Ali & Andy returned to

1. Turn Davis' station? from Foster. To the right left in passage explored by Paul Wunder at Foster. To the left is large passage Patrick + Carmen had climbed up into from Torsa Chamber. Straight on was my reached last some fine formations. We set off along this passage in full grabbing mode. On the left we noted a fire goat. Passage continued passing under organ pipes. An inlet was noted on the RHS. Passage ended at small stal blockage with no draft. However hole in right hand wall gave access to parallel passage. At a junction left ledge cut lead to a crawl & bend to the right. This popped out into much larger chamber with fine formations. Progress was stopped by hole in the floor. A continuation can be seen beyond. A return is planned. On the way out met Patrick + Carmen. They entered inlet on RHS (on the way in see above) this went for 40ish meters, starting as walkway but reducing to hands + knees before choke. Many photos were taken on the return. At your noted above it is ~~past~~ passage continues to gain height. Patrick + Carmen climbed into from chamber.

31/7/06 Revisit to Easter extension in Riano.

Footleg, Caroline Fretwell, Corner, Patrick.

Return to passages discovered at Easter up inlet on left at upstream end of double barrel passage. Proceeded up inlet (tortuous tight rift with sections of flat out traversing) to where it breaks out into chamber with hanging death roof pendants. Up slope in chamber leads to small holes which lead into larger sparkly chamber discovered at Easter but unsurveyed. Investigated leads and completed survey. Most passages choked with mud but one winding crawl leads to too tight section with draught.

Back in hanging death chamber, climb up to west and traverse over top leads to continuation phreatic passage. After false floor and sand floored section with formations, a body size crawl leads to 3-m climb down into room with conical funnel floor leading to hole (4-5m deep with over hanging pebble & sand lip. Undescended). Passage on turns 180° at end and stops. Possible continuation beyond funnel at roof level, but unable to climb up loose vertical sediment wall on opposite side from entry. Space above sediment is crawling height and can be seen to go about 10m before lost to site. Maybe bolting along wall could gain entry?

Back in hanging death chamber inlet off top of aven up from stream was followed until snaggy walls and arduous nature deterred further progress.

The first junction on RHS (Hysteria 69) led back to start of passage. To the right at major junction away under boulders led to stal grotto, and a short climb down which divides and becomes to narrow both ways. just is to RHS an underended pitch of Sm is followed after 90° bend by another pitch of Gm both to be descended. Opposite last pitch a high traverse + climb down enters an area of block worked limestone with narrow slot in floor which appears to open up below.

Left at main junction easy walking per stalks ad curtains Andy's Back passage is narrow around two tight corners to a climb down with two ways on, both to be pushed and surveyed.

Two other side passages appear to be choked with mud.

Just past RH bed a Human skull was found, surveying stopped here.



Peter spotted a slope down at the top chamber which could be pushed by small fit healthy types. Drops down about 30-40 feet.



5/8/06 Chris Smith, John Clarke + H. Long - Fresno area

Set off to go to Carrizo Cave, but digressed to look at a possible spot glimpsed briefly yesterday. This revealed a strongly outward draughting undercut and once a few rocks were removed a slope lead to top of a 5.5 metre p.tcl. Landing was a debris cone bridged over a further 10m drop but to either side was open passage. To the north was 6m wide, but needed digging to make progress to where it disappeared out of sight. In opposite direction went to a diggable bit with strong draught coming towards us. Heroic by John + Chris got us all tho! (me - finally) and to a further dig. After 4 hr in total we were thru and off into open passage. Mostly hand + knee crawling in varying width passage took us past several junctions to where John set off down a passage on the right. On his return he said he'd gone about 90-100m to where it continued the same ahead. There were various side passages and he left them all and rejoined us in the other route. This had side leads to pursue, but the main passage got to a flat out crawl, which may need a bit of digging, and with the very strong draught blowing into our faces. A conservative estimate of the length seen to date is c 200 metres.

22/08/06. Footleg & Caroline Freshell.
Riano trip to old high level fossil passages.

Descended through entrance series, double barrel passage, from junction with cat print passage, pass over with loop of rope hanging down and into triangular chamber where stream is met crossing left to right. Opposite is a sandy embankment which was followed to the right and ascended at the right hand edge. This ends at a rift where there is a climb up onto a plateau. ^{We went} directly across the plateau 90° from the rift to find a rift going off to the right. (there are several rifts crossing each other here.) This was traversed and then dropped down. We continued upwards to pop out in the middle of the large fossil passage. From here we turned right and explored the large chamber on the right hand side. This contained a number of bones

size boulders requiring a little care due to the house sized gaps between them. An old fossil passage intersected the chamber. Right this led to an aron, straight on it dished and left led back around the chamber. Chamber was sketched.

Back into the large old passage we tended left (under a large boulder) to where it ends, with a pit in one corner. Unsure how deep it was. We turned back and tended left through a zig zag before finding the passage leading to the top of the pitch with the rope top hanging down after cut point passage. On about the third corner down the passage on the left hand side were some long brown needle like crystals laying in the sand.

We made our way back to the point where we came in and surveyed from a previous survey marker No 10 ~~30/08/86~~ 30/08/86 back through the the end of double barrel passage, making some sketches as we went.

Would finally like to share with you summary of our Uzueka trip

Proff and david

Uzueka-Trip to bolt into passage in gour inlet. 7th August

Proff and I were up against the clock as we had a plane to catch. With planning that could have graced the swiss train system, we arrived in gour inlet. we were both very very impressed really lovely inlet with nice walking and formations not the grotty inlet we expected. (Well except for first 5m)

This inlet arrives at big chamber 25m+ high, with the inlet water coming from boluders in one wall at floor level. The previous people had climbed an overhanging crack on right wall, I was not equipped for such feats of strength and so went on opposite wall in a corner that looked easy by comparision.

A few bolts, a pull on a stal and I was 5m up and it then looked like an easy traverse with footholds! Couple of bolts later and the sad reality, sandstone (previously this stopped them reaching the obvious passage). By going back right a little and up- whilst thinking light thoughts (less than perfect calcite rubbish)- I was above the sandstone, once more breathing normally, in lovely hard limestone. Stretching back for 20m to the passage, the traverse continues in the band of hard limestone, about 12m off the floor. Easy bolting.....?! From the new vantage point, the passage does not exist, but there maybe continuation-basically above the inlet back towards the main passage. Also chamber continues up for another 30m+.

All in all interesting and worth another day, so 24m rope left in place, which will be enough to reach sudo passage. Next time I will take more rope just in case climb up needs to be continued.

Not sure sitting waiting is so interesting, so would also take a bar to have a prod at the boulder choke with water coming from it. This would pass the time if nothing else-not sure if this has been done before?

Way out was easy and arrived at the car in accordance with timetable. hurried washing of kit (sorry Phil and thanks) and break neck drive saw us arrive, a little dirty, 5minute before check-in closed. Phewh!

Juan also have some questions

As you leave gorilla walk and enter the 1st part of near stumps, you turn right (going into cave) then climb up boulder pile on LHS to calcited boulders. Has anyone spent time looking up calcite boulders here? Feels such big change in passage wonder if "missing" something in roof.

Also has 4th river been looked at yet with drill and climbing? Was thinking if GI stops, whilst we are there with a drill maybe option.

Herewith various bits. The names on the Huerto Rey survey are fairly obvious, but G G's Gallery (Glory Grabber's) starts at the junction with Whippet's Way - don't ask! There are various other names already given to parts seen but not yet surveyed.

✓ The stuff at Secadura, from Easter, should be as per positions shown on enclosed map; some of your dots are way out. Don't know what you have done with some of the text, as the description for site 2387 (the resurgence) is the same as that for site 2386 - which is shown correctly. I've no doubt you'll sort it out OK.

? Have noticed the following errors. Site 2477 - the photo says outside site 2477, ✓
Carcass Cave, which it obviously isn't! Site 2452 is the same photo as site 2453. The survey for Famous Five Cave doesn't start at the dot on the pdf map.

✓ Talking of dots on maps. Would it be possible to show somehow those dots which have been obtained by gps as opposed to dead reckoning from the old mapping? If it could be done - perhaps by using a different colour for the number - it would mean anyone who has a gps, and goes to an entrance with an out of date position, could do an update. In the same vein, is the business we talked about on the phone re. the use of the digital mapping for deriving altitudes of entrances. Again, some way of differentiating between old and new data would be advantageous. What do you think?. I realise this may involve quite a considerable amount of work!

Now for my wish list (ha ha). Would it be asking a lot for a copy of a survex 3d file showing El Torno, Huerto Rey, Fresnedo 2, Fresnedo 1 (with z's if available) and also Nacimiento del Campiazo with all of the entrance altitudes derived from the new digital mapping? My best guess for the altitudes of Fresnedo 1 and Fresnedo 2 are 126m and 128m respectively - something like 8 metres lower than they are shown currently, although it depends where you take the level for Fresnedo 1. Also, the positions are possibly slightly adrift, and site 994 is shown on the wrong side of the valley i.e. it wants moving westwards. I think Footleg gps'd all of the entrances and it would be interesting to see what he got. Nacimiento del C is something like 94 metres on the digital mapping, not the 120 metres it is shown on the web site.


There you are, not too much to ask for!!! Well, I can live in hope. It would be very useful to have, though, because it is starting to look as if the canal in Huerto Rey is lower than the level of Nacimiento del Campiazo, and also, with revised entrance alt. for Fresnedo 2 it puts the lowest point only about 2 or 3 metres above N d C but about 1.5 kilometres horizontal distance. Not impossible I agree, but unlikely. Would make an interesting system if Huerto Rey has split flows (like Rianio) and drains to N d C as well as to one of the Secadura risings such as Crecidas!

All for now. Might get to the conference for a change this year.




